Thames Valley Air Ambulance Ride Out for Rescue 2024 Terms and Conditions

In taking part in Thames Valley Air Ambulance's 'Ride Out for Rescue' Event I accept, agree and confirm that:

- I am familiar with the nature of the activity I wish to undertake and accept that, despite Thames Valley Air Ambulance and Unity Support Riders taking all reasonable precautions, damage and injury may occur, I accept these risks and take part in this activity at my own risk.
- I will not be under the influence of alcohol on the ride out and I am not taking any drugs that may impair my ability to take part.
- I hold a full/provisional valid DVLA motorcycle driving licence (not applicable to pillions).
- The motorcycle I intend to use is safe and I have valid insurance, tax and an MOT (if required). Any on vehicle camera or other equipment is safely and securely attached, using mounting systems specifically designed for that purpose. I understand that Thames Valley Air Ambulance's insurance will not cover damage to my vehicle (whether controlled by me or any other person) at this event and I take responsibility for any damage caused to my vehicle (whether controlled by me or any other person).
- Full protective equipment including a properly fastened crash helmet and clothing will be worn at all times on the ride out.
- I will adhere to directions from the Unity Support Riders marshals and ensure that I follow any instructions made by them on the ride out. There will be a safety briefing for all participants prior to the ride out commencing.
- I will ride within my own limits & capabilities and I will not endanger other road users or spectators along the route.
- I understand that this is not a race and I will adhere to speed limits and the rules of the road and ride with due care and attention given to all other road users at all times.
- No claim of any kind arising from my own negligence, error or omission or otherwise (including without limitation in respect of any damage to any vehicle or other equipment I intend to use at the event) shall be made by me, my guests or on my behalf against Thames Valley Air Ambulance, Unity Support Riders or any other participant in the event.
- Entries are non-refundable. If the Event 'Ride Out for Rescue' needs to be postponed for any reason including but not limited to inclement weather or any other circumstances outside of our control, entries will be transferred to a new date which will be notified to participants as soon as possible. If the Event 'Ride Out for Rescue' has to be cancelled, the motorbike patches will be sent out to participants.
